

1. Watch chapter 9 (16:24–19:51) from the animated Complete Learning System, *The Greatest is the Least* DVD. (Video clip is also provided for viewing online.)

2. Read John 13:34–35

“A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.”

3. When Jesus gave this new commandment to “love one another” (John 13:34–35), was He speaking only to His twelve disciples? (No.)

What is a disciple? (One who believes in and follows Jesus.)

How can we show Jesus that we are His disciples? (By loving one another and keeping the commandments.)

4. How do we know that God loves us?

(He provided a Savior for us, so we can return to live with Him.)

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” (John 3:16.)

5. Is love important? (Yes.)

“Love is of the very essence of life...Love is the security for which children weep, the desire of youth, the cement that binds marriage, and the smoothing oil that prevents devastating friction in the home; it is the peace of old age, the sunlight of hope shining through death.
